

Study Tour of Zoology Department

We organized one day study tour of B. Sc. Final year students of Zoology. As a study tour is compulsion to visit a fish farm and study parameters like physical and chemical factors etc. on 05January 2020, we visited fish farm that was known by the name "Maharashtra Fish Seed Production Center" Kesapuri Camp, Majalgaon Dist.Beed.

The aim of this farm is to production of seeds and supplies various farmers. Near about 6 hectors area of this farm. The soil is clay which is better water retention capacity. Various types of ponds are constructed by digging the land. Pond consists, of stocking rearing, breeding and nursery ponds for various purposes.

There are 6 types of fish species were cultured namely Indian major carps i.e. *catla catla, Labeo rohita, Cirrhinus mrigala*, Silver carp - *Hypopthalmichthyes molitrix*, grass carp - *Ctenopharyngodon idella* and common carps - *Cyprinus carpio*. They are developed in the pond water, but did not breed in captivity. Naturally they breed in riverine conditions at the time of breeding season. When fish seed collected from such forces there is mixture of various fish seed desirable and undesirable species.

For obtaining pure fish seed or such species is very difficult to farmers for solving this problem this fish farm owner developed a special type of induced breeding technique, breeding devices consist of Chinese breeding pond, Bangla bundh, incubation tank, seed collection chamber, overhead tank.

Indian major carps and chinses carps breed during the monsoon months i. e. June to August. The common carp breed twice a year in the months of June and December. For breeding of Indian major carps and Chinese carps, the male and female infected with ovaprim (containing Gn RHA dopamine antagonist dompendone). Dose is varying from species to species and sex to sex. Injected brooder

released into breeding tank. After 6 to 8 hours of injection they breed. Fertilization external, fertilized

eggs collected into incubation tanks. These spawns transferred into hapa kept remain there for 3 days,

then transferred into nursery ponds. After 15 days rearing ponds or transport to fish farmer.

Common carp - Cyprinus carpio breed in breeding hapa which is arranged in pond, they don't

need any inducement.

For fish seed transportation, there is oxygen cylinder carton box, polythene bags etc. this whole

transportation system is seen by our students practically. For fish seed transportation first fish seed are

collected and stored in small hapa or cement cistern. Then supply to the polythene bag containing water

this bag also filled with oxygen, and then packed the mouth of bag. This bag is kept in a cartoon. This

is ready for transportation. This seed is transported various places.

For food purposes, the spawn and fry, the nursery pond is well prepared by manuring,

developing planktons, zooplanktons and phytoplankton. For larger fishes used cow dung and rice.

For manuring of ponds used organic fertilizers like cow dung, line is also used to kill the

parasites as well as to correct the pH of water and soil.

All our students observed all the techniques practically on the field. This is definitely very

beneficial to our students. They can also develop the fish farm after completion of their degree. They

can own develop their employment and also give employment to the other persons also. On the whole

day we are on the farm and observed various techniques and then return back in the evening.

For the success of this tour, efforts have been taken by all teaching and non-teaching staff. The




